"Well Joy S., are you prepared to become a candidate to serve as a World Service Delegate for three years?"

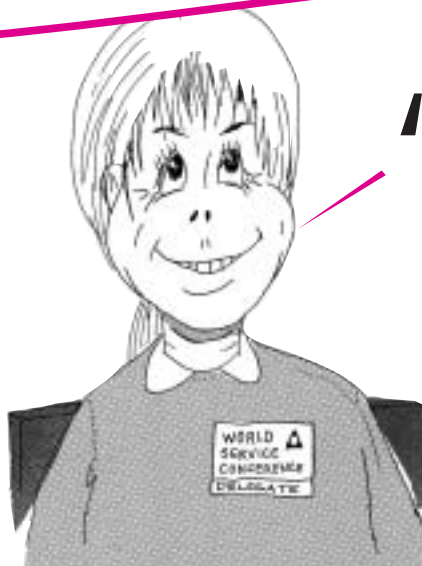
